## Martin Luther King Day - Jan 15th, 2024

In the U.S., Martin Luther King Ir., Day is observed annually on the third Monday in January. The day commemorates the life and work of Dr. King, who was a Baptist minister and prominent leader in the American civil rights movement. People are encouraged to use the day to "reflect on the principals of racial equality and the nonviolent social change" championed by Dr. King.

Dr. King was born on January 15th 1929. He rose to the front of the civil rights movement in 1955 during the Montgomery Bus Boycott. Inspired by Mahatma Gandhi's philosophy, Dr. King promoted the use of nonviolent means to bring about social and racial changes to the United States. (Amy McKenna, 2016, Britannica.com: 2023)
